“You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you”

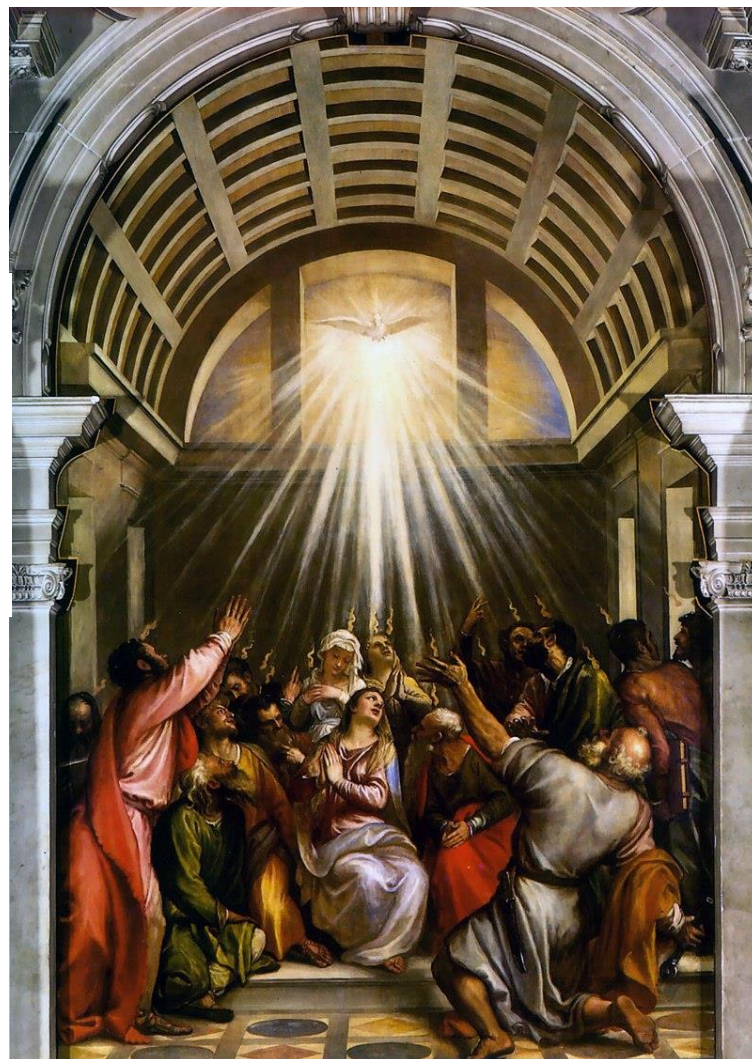
Paul wrote:
