Where and when

We are open Monday – Saturday between 10.30am and 3.30pm, and Sundays between 7.30am and 3.30pm. Please look at our website for further updates. Our risk assessment is also available on the website.

Things you need to know when visiting us during this time

If you are unwell, sadly, we have to ask you not to come to St. Michael's at this time, but please do contact us through our website or using the details above

If you develop Coronavirus symptoms within a week after visiting us, please let the church caretaker know on church.caretaker@smng.org.uk or by calling 01865 255779.

If a queue is needed, this will be East down Ship Street, with social distancing encouraged, using markers on the pavement

The entrance is on Ship Street

We are operating a one-way system around the church, which is clearly signposted

There will be someone on hand at the church entrance to explain our route around the church and manage the space

We have an NHS QR code for Track and Trace which you can scan when entering: Alternatively, you can send your contact details and details of your visit to the vicar on vicar@smng.org.uk or you can give your details to the volunteer on duty who can take them down on paper

We are asking everyone to use hand sanitizer (which will be provided) before entering the building

Unless you are exempt, by law you should wear a face covering while in church

Pews are clearly marked to show where you can sit, to ensure social distancing
